Williams D. Nichols, born October 3, 1944 and passed away June 7, 2022 at his brother's home in Corsicana, Texas at the age of 77. He is now with our Lord Jesus Christ.

He was a Native of Hayesville, NC. He was preceded in death by his father, Huston Nichols and mother, Reba Hollifield Nichols.
