He was a member of Rotary, Lions Club and a Mason. He was a lifetime member of Texas State Teachers Association. David was a Sunday school teacher and Deacon of the First Baptist Church of Fairfield. He enjoyed square dancing, camping, hunting and playing games. He especially enjoyed playing dominoes with Harold Massey and beating Johnny McLeod. He loved playing games, fishing and staying up late watching TV with his granddaughters. David was a loving husband, father and grandfather.
