Adam Wayne Bonner passed away on Thursday, March 12th, 2015 in Chicago, Illinois. He was 30 years old.

Adam was born in Corsicana, Texas on March 2nd, 1985 to Wayne and Amy Bonner. He graduated from Corsicana High School and earned the rank of Eagle Scout. He then went on to receive a Bachelors in Sociocultural Anthropology from The University of North Texas. He recently received a certificate to teach English as a second language and was planning to teach in South America this year. He was a twice published poet.

Adam was a free spirit in every sense of the word. He was a fun-loving person who could strike up a conversation with anyone, and walk away with a new friend. He was a compassionate person who was accepting of all people. We considered him the family brainiac as he was always able to think outside the box. He relished a lengthy intellectual conversation on any topic.

Adam had eclectic tastes and held a variety of interests including: graphic design, photography, listening to NPR, watching Star Trek, playing cards, studying classic literature, writing poetry, admiring beautiful sunsets, collecting vinyls, listening to all genres of music, playing the drums, and very seldom would you find him without an over-sized mug of coffee in his hand.

Adam was preceded in death by his grandmother Valda Dean Lonon Bonner and niece May Clara Bonner.

He will forever be loved and remembered by his parents Wayne and Amy Bonner of Corsicana; brother, Andrew and wife Casey of Eureka; sister, Allison Rogers, husband Ryan of Corbet and favorite nephew Will; grandparents, Tommy and Judy Baumgartner of Corsicana, Leroy Bonner of Corsicana; beloved companion Hannah Rogers of Corsicana, numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.

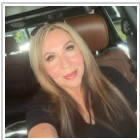
