Bennie Ruth Brewer James, 81, passed away peacefully in February 2025, leaving behind a legacy of faith, love, and service. Born on August 17, 1943, in Mississippi, Bennie spent her formative years there before making Corsicana, Texas, her home for the past two decades. Throughout her life, she was a beacon of light in her church and community, known for her unwavering devotion to God and her selfless dedication to others.

Bennie's profound faith was the cornerstone of her life. She had a lifelong passion for guiding others toward experiencing the joy and love of an intimate relationship with God, mirroring her own deep connection. Her home became a sanctuary for many, as she regularly hosted Bible studies and prayer gatherings, fostering spiritual growth and fellowship. With a nurturing heart, Bennie embraced numerous individuals as her spiritual sons and daughters, offering them wisdom, guidance, and unconditional love on their faith journeys.

Family was the heart of Bennie's world. She is survived by her devoted husband of 60 years, Floyd James; Beloved brother and Sister, Mike Brewer and Naomi Brewer. Her son, Scott James; and her daughters, Kim Trewern (and husband Jay) and Jodi Price (and husband Kirk). Bennie was a proud grandmother to Kim and Jay's sons, Ben Kissee and Alex Kissee; and to Jodi and Kirk's children: only granddaughter Megan Hernandez (and husband Zachary, along with 4 great grandchildren) and grandson Will Price (and wife Haley). Her family was a testament to her love, prayers, and unwavering support.

Something that many may not know about Bennie is that she was a woman of courage and adventure. She was recruited into the FBI in college. She boarded a bus and went to work in Washington D.C. at the J. Edgar Hoover FBI. Later, she worked for NASA and then finished her career working for the United States Navy. Once, when her children were teenagers, she was riding a horse up a steep mountain trail. The horse lost its footing and begin to slide off of the mountain cliff. She bailed off the horse, injuring herself but saving the life of the horse! She was amazing.

Bennie's selfless spirit, boundless kindness, and steadfast faith have left an indelible mark on all who had the privilege of knowing her. While her physical presence will be deeply missed, her legacy continues to inspire and guide. We celebrate Bennie's life as a shining example of devotion, compassion, and love, cherishing the profound impact she had on her family, friends, and community.

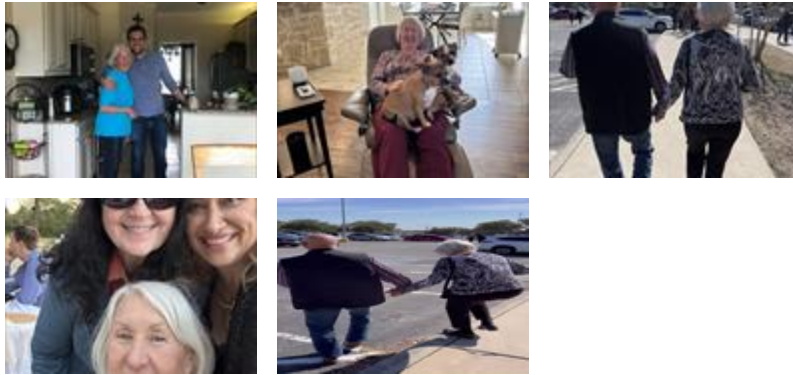
