Bernice Fisher, of Corsicana, Texas, went to be with the Lord Jesus Christ, Saturday morning, June 18, 2016. She was born March 10, 1922, in Drumright, Oklahoma, received a Master's Degree and served as a Registered Nurse in Oklahoma, and later, in the Dallas, Texas area for many years. A memorial Service will be held for Ms. Bea at Park Meadows Church, 3401 Country Club Road, Corsicana, Texas, at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, June 22.

Also, they hosted Home Bible Studies several days a week for many years. People from different towns and different denominations attended and were blessed by Bro. Otis' amazing and deep Bible teaching, and Ms. Bea's wise insights and

her lively sense of humor, and quick wit.

Bernice was one of eleven children born to Jesse and Martha Bull.

She is survived by one sister and one brother, Ina (Sis) Adler of Caldwell, Idaho, and Bob Bull, of Dallas, Texas.

She was preceded in death by her husband Otis, her daughter Beverley West, and eight of her siblings who were:
