I have seen her take part in building a multi-million dollar building for the Albuquerque Rescue Mission. While they were missionaries in the Fiji Islands, she had a great influence on the people of Fiji and the surrounding nations.

After being away from Fairfield for 48 years, upon her return to Fairfield she instantly began to volunteer in multiple organizations like The Fairfield Chamber of Commerce, The Cancer Support Group, she was also involved with FIRD and TMA, and many other organizations.

She was amazing and had an amazing heart and never met a stranger.
