December 14, 1947 - January 18, 2008

Beverly Caffy Hanks died at approximately at 1:15 p.m. on Friday, January 18, 2008 at the Navarro Regional Hospital.

Beverly was born December 15, 1947 in Frost, Texas as the daughter of James David Caffy and Lucille Ballew Caffy.

Her family lived in the Western Navarro County community of Emmett as she matured and attended Frost ISD schools.

Beverly was an active student in activities and sports at Frost High School graduating with various recognitions from her fellow students in 1966.

In the late 1960's and early 1970's Beverly lived in Corsicana and worked at Hanks Insurance and Medical Arts Clinic. She was an active member of the Corsicana Country Club serving on the Entertainment Committee.

In 1975, Beverly moved with her daughter, Mandi to Arlington where she became an instructor at Ogle's School for Hair Design. Later she was a hairdresser for Shelton's in Arlington before she moved to Dallas and joined the staff at Allan Stone Hair Salon.

In the late '90's she became Customer Service Manager for the Texas Room Store organization.

Beverly moved back to Corsicana in 1999 and lived in Corsicana for the remainder of her life.

Beverly is survived by her daughter, Mandi, many cousins and countless good friends throughout Texas.

A Memorial Celebration of Life for Beverly Hanks will be held Saturday,

January 26th at 2:00 p.m. in the Emmett Church in the Emmett Community in Western Navarro County.
