BILL EUGENE GRAY FEBRUARY 27, 1946 - MARCH 06, 2009 A Husband, Father, Grandfather, Brother and Friend Bill Gray of Streetman, TX passed away on March 6, 2009 after a long and brave fight with cancer over the last two years. He moved his family into a home he built on acreage in 1998 from Dallas and retired from the construction trade in 2007. Bill was born in Barton County Kansas and lived with his parents and three brothers near Claflin, KS until the family moved to Hoisington, KS when he was nine years old. The family later moved to Wichita, KS where he graduated from Campus High School in 1964. He started his career in the construction trade in Kansas City and later moved to Texas where for many years was the project manager for several large projects around the State of Texas. Bill is survived by his wife of 24 years, Evelyn, and four children: sons Michael Gray, Dallas, TX and, John Gray, Corsicana, TX and daughters Ameer Hooper, Corsicana, TX and Nikki Williams, Kilgore, TX. Bill has 6 grandchildren: Sierra, Shane, Cole, Triniti, Madison and Kira. Two brothers, Wayne of Holualoa, HI and Donn of Wichita, KS, also survive him. His father Basil A. Gray, mother Leona G. Gray and brother James Gray preceded him in death. From 1968 to 1971, Bill served with honor in the U. S. Army. While serving a tour of duty in Viet Nam, he was decorated with the Purple Heart and the Silver Star for bravery. He enjoyed working in his yard, fishing as time allowed and visiting with his many friends and neighbors.
