William Earl “Bill” Brown, born June 11, 1955, to William Travis Brown and Oneda Olivia Petty Brown in Corsicana, Texas, peacefully went home to be with the Lord on December 30, 2025; surrounded by his loved ones. He has won his earthly battle.
