Billy Patrick Dosser of Corsicana, TX passed away Thursday June 23, 2022, at the age of 69 with family at his side.

Bill was born on March 5, 1953, to parents Ann and Woodrow Dosser in Corsicana, Texas.

He graduated from Corsicana High School in 1971 and Navarro College in 1973. He retired from Southwestern Bell in 2003 after 30 years of service.

Bill had many hobbies and spent much of his free time volunteering for several organizations such as the Palace Theatre and the Corsicana Weather Radar. He was also a member of the Corsicana Police Department Reserves for several years. He made numerous friends from around the world through his interest in electronics and as a HAM Radio Operator.
