Carolyn graduated from Corsicana High School in 1937. She married Lyman Barnes in 1944. They were married for more than 49 years.

Carolyn was a very talented pianist and organist. She gave piano lessons for over 60 years and played at St. Luke's United Methodist Church. She enjoyed playing at the Seventh Day Adventist Church for many years where she was a member. As a youth, she studied piano at the Marie Waltman School of Music. She also attended Hill Community College for one semester.

For many years, Carolyn played the piano for the Rotary Club. She is in The Piano Guild Hall of Fame.

Carolyn is survived by sons Darrell and Lyman Barnes, Jr. of Corsicana and Randall Barnes of Phoenix, Arizona. In addition, she has a niece, Melissa Miller, and nephew, Denny Megarity, as well as countless friends and piano students who have fond memories of her.
