Eddie Hambrick, 54, went to his eternal resting place with Christ, October 7, 2010, at home surrounded by his family, after a seven year battle with renal cell cancer. He was born March 30, 1956 in Alvin, Texas. He was valedictorian of his 1974 graduating class in Grapeland, Texas. He graduated from Texas A&M in 1978 and also completed a Masters in Horticulture from A&M. He was preceded in death by his mother Estha Maye Hambrick. He is survived by his wife of fourteen years Denise Hambrick; daughter Rebecca Joy and son Michael Edward; sister and brother-in-law Martha and Darrel Brown; brother and sister-in-law Bill and Lil Williams; brothers-in-laws and sisters-in-laws, Wayne and Judy Nelson, Billy and Pat Nelson, John and Rosemary Nelson, Lynette and Gary Bailey, Patresa Nelson Bolton and Vicki Nelson Farmer; mother-in-law Joy Horn Nelson. Eddie was a man of deep faith in Christ, strong convictions and unswerving loyalty to his family and friends. His passions were demonstrated at St. John's Episcopal Church in his service as Senior Warden and organizer of mission trips to Burkina Faso, Africa. He spent countless hours in service with his friends in the Corsicana Lions Club. Eddie also embraced the men and vision of Gideon's organization and labored with them to bring the Bible to seekers here and around the world. A memorial service will be held Friday, October 15, 2010 at 2:00pm.
