Charles Eugene "Charlie" Sikes, Sr., age 67, passed away on January 1, 2026, in Cotulla, Texas. Born on February 14, 1958, in Corsicana, Texas, Charlie lived a life marked by dedication to his family, service to his country, and an unmatched talent for fixing the seemingly unfixable.

Charlie graduated from Fairfield High School in 1977 and soon after began a distinguished career in the United States Air Force. Serving as a Sergeant and airplane mechanic at Dyess Air Force Base in Abilene, Texas, he honed the skills that would define much of his life's work.
