“ My family & I are deeply saddened by the death of Charlie. He and my Dad, along with many others, served in Company A, 335th Engineers, US Army during WWII. Unlike most who served in infantry or other divisions, this Company of soldiers stayed together for the duration of the War, spending over 3 years together. The bond created by 'going to hell & back together' (in the words of one of their sergeants) was strong enough that Charlie was determined to find his 'brothers' in the early 1960s. He started what became a bi-annual reunion beginning in Colorado in 1964 & traveling to Missouri, Illinois, Minnesota, Kentucky, Tennessee, Oklahoma and continues today with the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren of these brave men, who all became 'family' because of our Dads and Charlie's persistence in locating and gathering the men of Company A to share memories, post-war lives and families. Of the entire Company, it seems symbolic that Charlie was the last survivor. Thank you, Charlie Boyd, for your service to our country and for giving us an extended family across this country. You will be greatly missed.

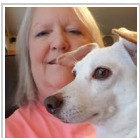

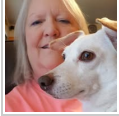
