Cheryl Ann Barker, resident of Streetman, passed away on Sunday, June 24, 2012 at Baylor Medical Center in Dallas at the age of 37 from injuries she received at a rodeo accident. She was born in Kilgore, Texas to David Rowe and Judy Temple Rowe on June 11, 1975. She and her family moved to Streetman eleven years ago and made thier home in the Streetman Community. Cheryl loved her children, animals of all shapes and sizes, and the place her family lived on. She was active in the 4H activities in Freestone County and loved being outside hunting, fishing, and working with the animals. Cheryl married Paul Barker on March 23, 1997 in Kilgore. She was a member of the Cowboy Heritage Church of Freestone County and was an instructor at Navarro Junior College in Corsicana. Cheryl is survived by her husband of 15 years Paul Barker of Streetman. Their children Samuel and Katie Barker of Streetman. Her mother and step-father Judy and Byron Mason of Kilgore and a brother John Rowe of Kilgore and half sister Cathy Harris. She was preceded in death by her father David Rowe. Visitation will be held on Thursday evening from 6 - 8pm at Griffin - Roughton Funeral Home in Fairfield. Funeral services will be held on Friday, June 29, 2012 at 10am at Calvary Baptist Church in Fairfield with Jimmy Cotton officiating. Burial will follow at Woodland Cemetery in Kirvin.
