Chester W. Long, 75, of Balch Springs, Texas passed away peacefully at his residence on February 5, 2019.

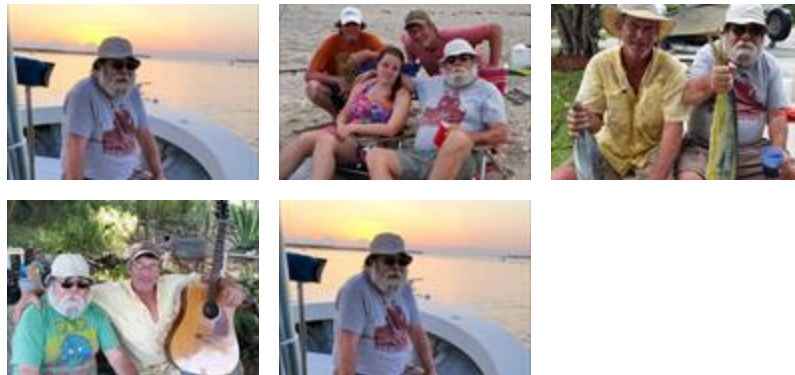

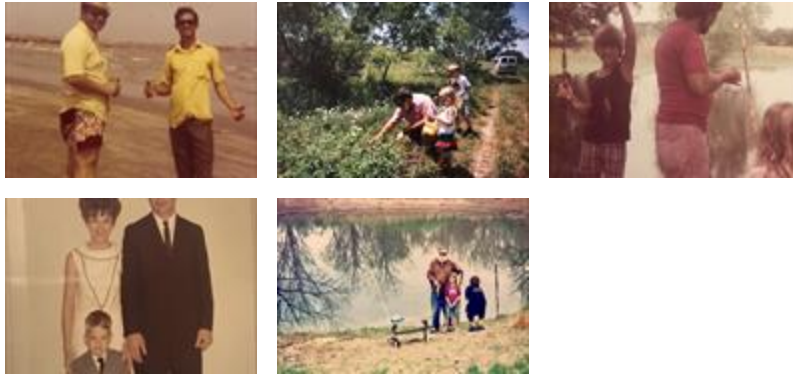

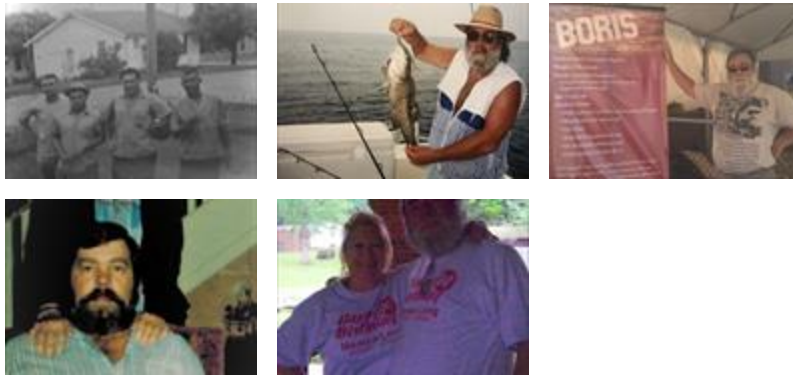
