



Chlois "Smitty" Smith

December 31, 1926 - February 9, 2015

Chlois Gene "Smitty" Smith of Fairfield passed away in Temple, Texas at Scott and White Continue Care on Monday, February 9, 2015 at the age of 88. He was born in Turnersville, Texas to Davis Smith and Bertha Rushenburg Smith on December 31, 1926. Chlois served his country during World War II in the United States Army as a Paratrooper and later in the Merchant Marines. He enjoyed wood working, restoring old cars and hunting with his family. He was a 32 Degree Mason, 32 Degree Scottish Rite and a member of the Blue Lodge, and held membership in the Fairfield Lodge and Rockdale Lodge.
