



Clinton Kerr Cowan

February 27, 1948 - December 18, 2016

Clinton Kerr Cowan was born on February 27th, 1948 in Terrell, Texas. His parents were Kerr Bicknell Cowan and Iris Shepperd Cowan who were both originally from Corsicana. Shortly after Clinton's birth, his dad re-enlisted in the U.S. Army to continue a military career begun during World War II. Thus, Clinton became an Army kid, moving from post to post around the world with the family, which later welcomed a more junior member, his sister Bickie. The family lived in Arkansas, Okinawa (Japan), Arizona, Germany, and Georgia before his dad retired in 1969, and made a final move to Corsicana. Clinton soon became a regular fixture on the corner of 4th Avenue and 24th Street, greeting passers-by with a wave and a smile. Other places he could frequently be seen were on the porch swing of the Cowan home on West Fourth Avenue, in services at St. John's Episcopal Church, at the railroad depot at the south end of Beaton Street, at the Park Lanes Bowling Alley on Saturdays and thumping canned goods at Brookshire's when shopping with his mother. Once the Golden Circle Ranch became a viable workplace in the early 1970's, Clinton took his place as a participant in the program, enjoying the social connections and conviviality of the sheltered workshop. In recent years, he has lived in the Rescare group home on Oaklawn in Corsicana, where he reported that the food was always good and the he loved all the people. Clinton is survived by his sister, Bickie Cowan Roberts and husband Alan, of Mabank, a nephew, Jeffrey Roberts of Balmorhea, niece, Page Roberts Maughan and husband Zach of Logan, Utah, and niece, Lauren Roberts

Shafer and husband Luke of Tyler. He is also uncle to 7 great-nieces and great-nephews.
