May 10, 1933 - December 6, 2010

Cloratho Reamy, resident of Navarro Mills, went to be with his Lord and Savior at his home on December 6, 2010 at the age of 77 with his family at his side. He was born on May 10, 1933 in Pursley to Ogle and Willie Eslick Reamy. He served his country in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict from 1952 - 1955. Cloratho worked as a foreman in the oil production industry for more than 32 years. He was a member of the Navarro Mills Baptist Church and enjoyed going to bible class. He also enjoyed riding motorcycles and was a honorary member of the Blue Knights Motorcycle Club and his self proclaimed club "The Old Geiser's". He was preceded in death by his parents, son Clay Reamy, granddaughter Kristy Jennings, grandson Jason Barber, brother Lafamond Reamy and a sister Jo Kuyava. Survivors include his wife of 57 years Elizabeth Ann Reamy of Navarro Mills.
