Clyde Earl Smith, lifetime resident of Corsicana, Texas, and well-known air conditioning/heating service man for 60 years in the community, went to be with the Lord on October 23, 2023, at the age of 89. He was born on February 17, 1934, in Corsicana to Carl and Bessie Smith. He attended schools in Corsicana, Rice and Corbet. He met a cute carhop named Helen Andrews at a local drive-in. Let's just say that he ate a lot of hamburgers during that time. They married on December 29, 1954, and celebrated 56 years together. Clyde accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and was baptized at Calvary Baptist Church. In later years, he was a member of Trinity Baptist Church and First Baptist Church.

Clyde was a hard-working man, who provided well for his family. He fondly loved talking about the many jobs that he had such as working on the farm picking cotton, pumping gas, filling ice cream containers at the local creamery, operating a forklift at the brick yard, delivering wholesale groceries in surrounding towns and delivering Sunbeam bread. He will probably best be remembered as "the heating and air conditioner man." He worked at several air conditioning businesses before starting his own business. He was always busy and especially enjoyed helping widowed ladies at a discounted price.
