Coy Allen Spears Sr., resident of Corsicana and formerly of DeSoto, passed away at Heritage Oaks Retirement Village on Saturday, February 7, 2015 at the age of 92. He was born on January 30, 1923 in Cooper, Texas to William Allen Spears and Emmer Killebrew Spears. Allen served in the United States Coast Guard from September 1942 to September 1945 during World War II. Following his military service he went to work as a Fire Fighter with Dallas Fire Department for 25 plus years and was a member of the Masonic Lodge in the Dallas area. Allen was a member of the Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Ovilla.

Allen is preceded in death by his parents William and Emmer Spears and his wife Melba Dean Spears who passed away in 1993. He is survived by his children; Linda Thorne and husband Roy, Carol Mann, Kemp Spears and wife Kaye and Coy Allen Spears Jr. and wife Ann.
