Curtis Corbin Penney, 93, went to be with his Heavenly Father on Friday, October 7, 2011. He was born on May 30, 1918 to Charles and Georgia Penney in Navarro County. Visitation will be held on Sunday evening from 5 - 7pm at Griffin - Roughton Funeral Home. Graveside services will be held on Monday, October 10, 2011 at 11am at Hamilton - Beeman Cemetery with Pastor Rick Lamb of Northside Baptist Church officiating. He married Harmolene Burns Penny in June 1940. They were happily married for 68 years until her death in 2009.
