Ervin Dale Farmer, 65, of Angus passed away Monday, August 17th, 2020 in his home surrounded by family and friends. He fought a courageous fight, but lost his battle to cancer. Visitation will be Friday from 6 to 9 pm. Services will be Saturday, 10 am at Griffin-Roughton Chapel with services conducted by John Robinson. He began working with the Angus Volunteer Fire Department in 1986. Dale served in many capacities with the fire department, including fire chief for 28 years. He loved serving his community through the fire department and Navarro County Firefighters Association. He received several certificates of attendance for his devotion. He had a love and interest for motorcycles and classic cars. He was the most devoted father to his daughter, Crystal. I was proud to call him my Daddy. He was preceded in death by his mother, Delorise Farmer; grandparents: H. L. & Stella Goodman, T.O. & Myrtle Farmer, and Elmer & Allie Belle Marr;

great grandparents Mr. & Mrs. R. J. Carter; and numerous other beloved family members.

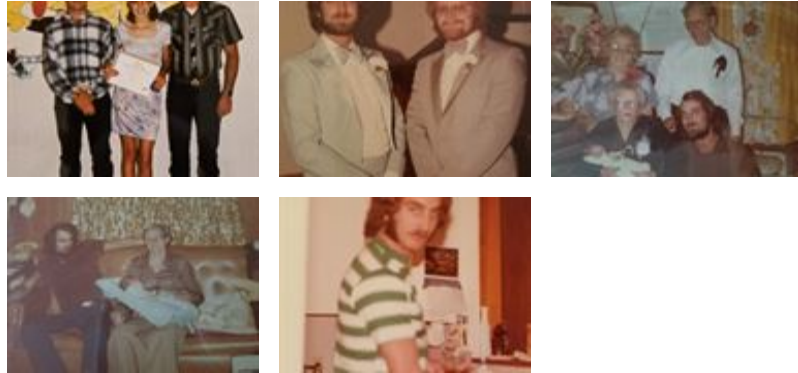

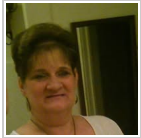

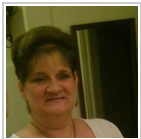
