Davey Randall Goff, age 70, of Frost, Texas, crossed the finish line one last time on April 12, 2025.

Born in Dallas and raised in Midlothian, Davey graduated from Midlothian High School in 1974. He spent the majority of his career in the trucking and transportation industry, working as a mechanic, driver, and dispatcher. He was known for his hardworking spirit, resourcefulness, and an uncanny ability to fix just about anything with wheels—or wings.

Davey had a lifelong love for speed and mechanics. He built and raced cars, trucks, motorcycles, planes, and helicopters. From top fuel dragsters to 10th scale RC cars and 24th scale slot cars, if it could race, Davey was in. He was a passionate hobbyist and always had a project (or three) going in the garage. He also had a deep love for blues and blues rock, especially anything featuring a soulful guitar solo. Music was always playing in the background, just behind the sound of tools and laughter. Davey's signature dry wit and perfectly timed dad jokes were a constant source of joy to those around him.

He is survived by his children Lauren McGee; Joshua Goff; Rachel and Tyler Briggs; and Leah and Jesus Rodriguez. He also leaves behind his sisters and

brothers-in-law LaDonna Goff Dean; Gary and Malea Caver; and John and Sandra Prokop. Davey was a proud grandfather to four grandchildren and a beloved uncle to many nieces, great-nieces, and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Fines and Lois Goff; his grandparents Roxie and Olie Goff, Jewel and Carson Roark; and his brother-in-law David Dean.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, May 17, 2025, at 1:00 p.m. at Frost Baptist Church, 101 Stroud St, Frost, TX 76641.

Davey will be remembered for his love of family, fast engines, slow blues, and the ability to turn any ordinary moment into a lasting memory—with a joke, a story, or a knowing smile. He left this world the way he lived in it: full throttle, with his heart in the right place and a spark in his eye.
