Visitation will be held from 6 to 8 p.m. today at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home. Service will be 2 p.m. Thursday at First Baptist Church with Dr. David Edwards and the Rev. B.F. Risinger Jr. officiating. Interment will follow at Oakwood Cemetery. He gained his nickname "Big Dave" because he was 6 feet and 9 inches, but his heart was much bigger. David was a Special Olympics coach for over 15 years. Last year at the area meet his family received the Family of the Year Award for Area 12 Chapter. Also for the past few years David and his family had been weekend house parents for Golden Circle Ranch, a house for the intellectually disabled. David and his wife taught missions to a group of 4 and 5 year olds every Wednesday at First Baptist Church. David leaves behind many friends and special athletes. David received his B.B.A. at UTA. He was an Eagle Scout with Boy Scouts of America. Survivors include his wife, Marjorie Bentz of Corsicana; three daughters, Jessica, Kristina and Rebecca, all of Corsicana; parents, Don and Jodie Bentz of North Richland Hills; brothers and sisters-in-law, William and Jean Bentz and Peter and Sandy Bentz, all of North Richland Hills; sisters, Cathy Curtis of Lockhart, Donna Smith of Arlington, and Barbara Bentz and Daren McAvoy of Providence, Utah; nieces and nephews, Shannon and Patrick Smith, Maren,
