



## David Crockett

October 5, 1919 - March 15, 2009

David Ray Crockett died Sunday, March 15, 2009 at the age of 89. He was born in Coleman, Texas on October 5, 1919 to Samuel B. and Mary Burns Crockett. Mr. Crockett was a skilled laborer for Whiteselle Brick and Lumber Company for close to 40 years. As a skilled laborer he was responsible for the firing and curing of bricks in the kiln. Many of the buildings in this area are built with the bricks under his watch. He was a World War II and as a testimonial of his honest and faithful service to his country, he was honorably discharged after 21 months of duty. He was stationed in Normandy, in Northern France where he served in the 552nd Coast Artillery Battalion; he served as a cook for one of the gun batteries. He worked with the C.C.C. (Conservation Construction Corp) that built fences and worked at rebuilding this country. Mr. Crockett lived at a time where a man's values were his family, his country and his work ethics. He was a member of the Emmanuel Baptist Church in Corsicana. He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Frances Crockett of Crockett; his children - Mary and James Robinson of Kilgore, James Crockett of Kerrville, Walter Crockett of Gilmer and Tammy and Mike Bryant of Corsicana; sister - Mary Whortor of California and a brother - Billy Ray Crockett of Bryan; 9 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews. Visitation will be Monday, March 16th at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Service will be Tuesday, March 17th at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home at 2:00 p.m. with Harold Scott officiating. Burial will follow in the Hamilton-Beeman Cemetery. Serving as
