Dianne Conner, age 64, was welcomed into Christ's loving arms Friday, July 29, 2011 at Navarro Hospital in Corsicana. Dianne was born on August 18, 1946 in Port Arthur, TX. Dianne was a loving daughter, wife, mother and grandmother. She was preceded in death by her father Jack Miguez and mother Ethel Miguez both of Port Arthur. Dianne is survived by her husband of 40 years Otis Conner of Corsicana. She is also survived by her sister Danette Kimbrough and husband Tip Kimbrough of Lumberton, her daughter Corrie Bell and husband Jacob Bell of Hewitt, son Matthew Conner and wife Vanessa Conner of Forney, three grandchildren Peter, Stephen and Elisabeth Bell all of Hewitt and a host of additional relatives and friends. She also served faithfully in every church that she attended since her relationship with Christ started on the dark Port Arthur road. Her service included playing the piano, teaching Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Women's ministry and many other activities.
