Dorothy "Dottie" Dickson, 64 died Wednesday, July 11, 2007 at Baylor Medical Center in Dallas, Texas. She was born in Dallas on February 28, 1943 to Lyndon A. and Othella Giles Walker. She was a member of the First Baptist church where she was involved with Team Kids, Community Bible Study and Delta Kappa Gamma. She taught school for 32 years as an elementary school teacher.
