Dorothy Fay Morris Hodge, loving wife, mother and devoted child of God, went to be with her Lord on September 28, 2023, at the age of 94. She and her husband James Edgar Hodge were residents of Corsicana, Texas. She was born Dorothy Fay Morris to Albert Christopher Morris and Flossie Anton Purcell Morris on August 15, 1929, in Dallas, Texas

Dorothy graduated from Midlothian High School as valedictorian of her class. After high school she attended North Texas State College where she met James. They were married in Midlothian, Texas on June 17, 1948. In 1960 they moved with their daughters to Athens, Georgia where James completed his education.
