Dorothy Elizabeth Carney Maupin, 95, passed away at Heritage Oaks Retirement Village in Corsicana on Wednesday evening, March 4. A graveside service will be held on Saturday, March 7, at 2:00pm in Oakwood Cemetery with Reverend B.F. Risinger, Jr. officiating. Mrs. Maupin was born in Gadsden, Alabama on November 29, 1913. She finished high school in Chatanooga, Tennessee and was a graduate of Judkins Commercial College in Pine Bluff, Arkansas.
