Dorothy Vacek, 73, of Corsicana passed away on December 20, 2008 at her home. Visitation will be held Monday evening from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. in Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home Chapel with a Rosary Service at 7:00 p.m. Funeral Mass will be held on Tuesday, December 23, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church. Interment will follow at Holy Cross Catholic Cemetery in East Bernard. Dorothy was born on June 27, 1935 to Frank John and Erma Annie Hoering Barta. She fell in love with home economics after taking her first course in 1953. She enrolled in Wharton County Junior College in 1953, and during orientation met a young man named Jerome Vacek. They were both enrolled in a dance class, and three times a week Jerome asked her to dance. He proposed to her on New Years Eve, 1955. They were blessed with three children. Dorothy taught home Economics for 44 years in El Campo, New Braunsfels, and at the Corsicana Independent School District. During her years in education she won numerous awards and honors. Upon retiring from CISD in 2005, Dorothy opened up an antique and gift shop in downtown Corsicana, and became involved in the Downtown Merchants Association, and very active in the Corsicana/Navarro County Chamber of Commerce. Dorothy and Jerome loved to travel and spend time with their family. They became tour directors and took small groups to see many parts of the world. She was preceded in death by her parents; brother, Raymond Barta; sister, Joyce Barta Ritter Roessing; and nephew, Dustin Barta. Survivors include her loving husband of

53 years Jerome; sister, Katherine Barta Cook and husband John; brother, Frank Barta and wife Kathy; sister, Mary Gonzales and husband Tom; sister, Janice Nelson and husband Perry; brother, John Barta and wife Debbie; daughters, Michelle Vacek Carpenter and husband Richard; Lisa Vacek Boesen and husband Mike; son, Chip Vacel and wife Page; nine grandchildren; six great grandchildren; numerous nieces and nephews.
