Douglas Kenneth Lane, resident of Trinidad, passed away on Sunday morning, May 27, 2012, at Trinity Mother Francis Hospital in Tyler at the age of 70 years. He was born in Paris, Texas on December 23, 1941 to Shield H. Lane and Mary Viola Grimes Lane. Mr. Lane married Avon Basham on February 10, 1962 at the Pacio Baptist Church and had celebrated their 50TH wedding anniversary. He had been the Superintendent of Mildred I.S.D. for 24 years retiring in 2011 and was a respected educator. He is preceded in death by his parents, siblings Clyde G. Lane, James R. Lane, Gerald R. Lane, Shield H. Lane Jr., Mae E. Beason, Florence Usery, and Betty J. King. Survivors include his wife of 50 years Avon Lane.
