Dr. James H. Barnebee Jr. Dr. James H. Barnebee Jr., 86, of Corsicana passed away Thursday, March 17, 2005 at Heritage Oaks Retirement Home. Visitation will be 6 to 8 p.m. today at Griffin-Roughton Funeral Home. Memorial services will be 2 p.m. Saturday at North Beaton Church of Christ with Russell Bankes officiating. Dr. Barnebee was born May 10, 1918 at Bluefield's, Nicaragua. During World War II he served as a captain in the Army Medical Corps. He came to Blooming Grove in 1945 to practice medicine. In 1954, he and his family moved to Corsicana to open the Physician and Surgeon Clinic with two other doctors. He was a member of the Navarro County Medical Society. For many years he was the director of the Navarro County Health Department. In his 55 years of his dedicated service as a physician, he reached out to many individuals regardless of their means. As a physician he birthed over 2,400 babies. He was preceded in death by wives Tony and Willie Barnebee. Dr. Barnebee is survived by his wife, Ingeborg Barnebee of Corsicana; sons and daughters-in-law, James H. Barnebee III, M.D. and Marie of Honduras, Michael Barnebee and Cheryl of Rhode Island, William Barnebee and Martha of Virginia, and Timothy Barnebee and Tonja of Corsicana; daughter, Johanna Barnebee of Oklahoma; stepchildren, Ingeborg Harris of Wills Point, Lother Harris and wife Earlene of San Antonio, Stephanie Chew and husband Bobby of Florida, and Jeanne Price and husband Emory of South Carolina; and his many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and the thousands of individuals he brought into this world.
