Wynn. Dale Houston Wynn was born in Enid, Okla., on Dec. 6, 1935. He married the love of his life, Barbara Anna Pedersen in Dallas on Dec. 27, 1955. After graduating from Amarillo High School, he attended four years at Texas Tech and completed his graduate studies in 1962 at Pacific University College of Optometry, Forest Grove, Ore. After practicing optometry from 1962 to 1964 in Herford, Texas, and from 1964 to 1983 in Ruidoso, N.M., he and his wife, Barbara, moved to Corsicana where they have served the community for 21 years at Texas State Optical. Dale's professional integrity and skill were only enhanced the more by his ready smile, uplifting spirit, and generous heart as he served his patients and lived his faith humbly. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, golfing, skiing, camping and just about anything in God's great outdoors. His children and grandchildren alike share many wonderful memories, as he involved each of them in a celebration of God's creation, taking them fishing and hunting ... just spending time with them in the outdoors.
