After serving in the U.S. Navy during World War II as a registered nurse, Bill received two bachelors, two masters, and two doctorate degrees in psychology and social science from several esteemed universities. He then went on to be a banker, barber and since January of 1951, a Church of Christ minister. His ministry lead him to travel in nine states and internationally to Europe. They included radio and TV communications, as well as the Texas Prison System. He taught in Public Schools, Fort Worth Christian College, Magnolia Bible College in Kosciusko, Mississippi, and the British Bible College in Corby, England.
