She loved to go on vacations and adventures with her family members, but especially loved her trips to Branson with Harry Lee. She is now

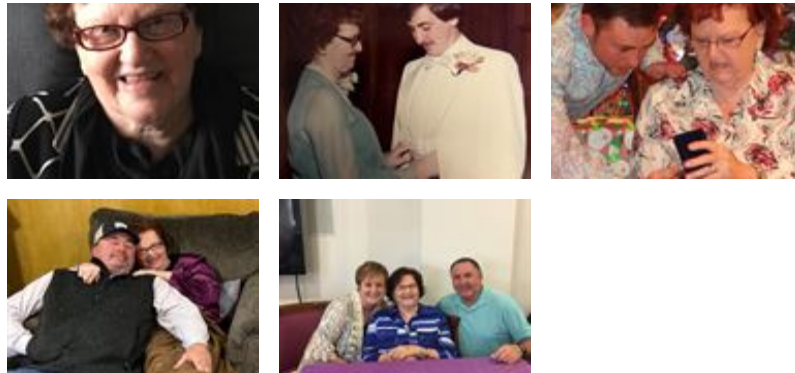
