Her first love was studying and teaching the Bible to others and making a joyful ?noise? to the Lord. She was preceded in death by her husband of 29 years, R.S. ?Mac? McGaha; mother and dad, Clyde and Rose Dale; and stepdaughter, Barbara Smith.
