who chose to share their own homes with four-legged friends of their own. She loved making the rounds of garage sales, flea markets, and antique shops looking for collectables and antique glassware. She had a quiet serenity about her but was known to be the proverbial mother bear when one of her cubs was in danger. Many a person caught a glimpse of "Wild Red" when her children were threatened. Her greatest joys in life however, were her grandchildren who were such a source of pride; just ask anyone she bragged to about them. In later years Geraldean was so happy to have her vision restored after surgeries so that she could once more read the novels she loved. Among her favorites was Author Dean Koontz.
