Guy Ronald Martin, 63, passed away Friday, October 9th, 2009 at Baylor Medical Center in Dallas. He was born in Lubbock, Texas on April 23, 1946 to Charles Martin and Dorothy McCarter Martin. He was reared in Frost and was a 1964 graduate of Frost High School and a 1968 graduate of Texas A & M Commerce. On December 4, 1970 he married Theresa Freen of Frost. After their marriage they lived in Ennis whee he taught school for twelve years before moving back to Frost to pursue his love of farming. He was a member of the Frost United Methodist Church. He also served as a director of Williams Gin and Grain and served on the Frost School Board for fifteen years. One of his favorite past times was spending time with his sons and friends deer hunting.
