Harold Louis Kreitner, 96, went to meet our Lord on Friday March 20, 2009. Harold was born May 8, 1913, in Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada. He became a Naturalized Citizen of the United States in June 1936. Harold married Edith V. Grauer of Niagara Falls, NY in June 1937. A year later Harold's brother, Maurice, married Edith's sister Ruth. The two families have always remained in a close, loving relationship. Harold went to work for Bell Aircraft, Wheatland Plant in Niagara Falls in 1943. In November 1951 the family moved to Richland Hills , where he was one of the employees who helped set up the operations of Bell Helicopter in Hurst. He retired as a Cost Accountant from Bell Helicopter in 1976. Harold and Edith took an active role in the foundation of Richland Hills United Methodist Church. The family were members of that church for many years. They also served The United Methodist Church in many capacities, both locally and nationally. Harold lost his wife and childhood sweetheart, Edith, in August of 1974. In October, 1977, he married Opal Harwood Males. He and Opal spent 24 years as sweethearts and best friends Opal preceded him in September, 2003. Harold moved to Streetman, to live with his daughter, Jan, in 2005. He was well-loved by all that knew him and made many good friends in his 96 years on earth. Harold left behind his daughters, Judy Kreitner and Rev.
