Harold Scott of Corsicana passed away at Baylor Medical Center in Dallas on Saturday, December 12, 2015 at the age of 76. Harold was born in Palestine, TX., on May 7, 1939 to Olen Melvin Scott and Mamie Jolley Scott. He married Norma McNeill on July 1, 1960 in Corsicana at Emmanuel Baptist Church. Harold was known for his great love for everyone and sharing Christ love. He served faithfully since he was a young boy. When attending a small country church he would walk to the church and light the fire to be sure it would be warm for others. He has served very faithfully all of his life. His favorite subject was LOVE, he was compassionate and had a very contagious smile. He loved the Lord first, family, church and everyone he met.

When he felt the call to God ministry he was so excited and could not wait to be called to a church. 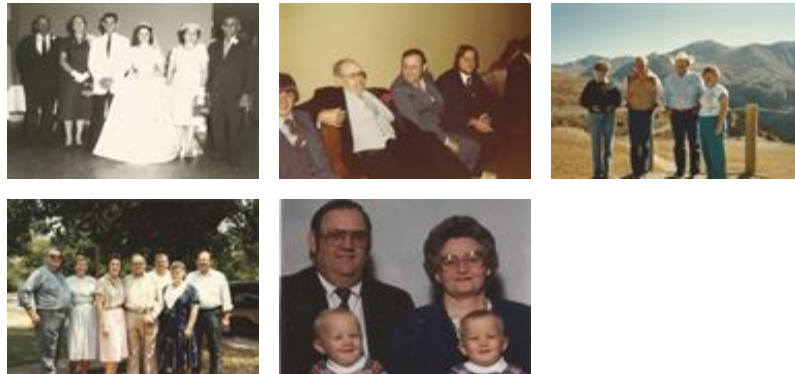

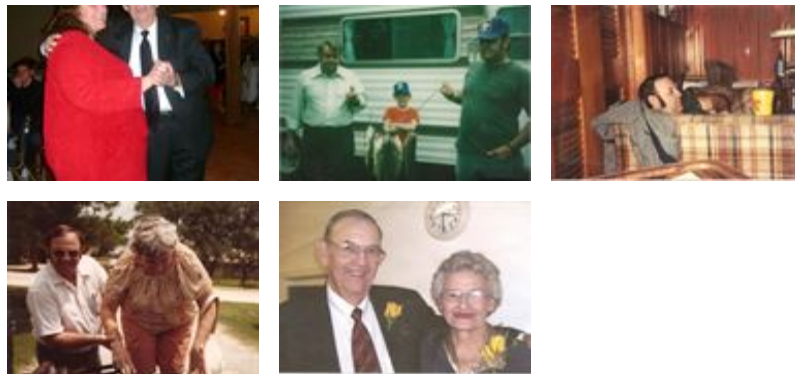
