June 19, 1928 - January 8, 2017

Hugh V. Fullerton, Jr. of Corsicana passed away Sunday, January 8 at the age of 88. He was born June 19, 1928 to Hugh V., Sr. and Willie Mae Fullerton. He was a faithful member of First Baptist Church where he was a member of the Sanctuary Choir. He served on the Corsicana I.S.D School Board for 8 years. He also served on the Board of First National Bank and its successors. Hugh was a member if the National and Regional Board of Affiliated Food Stores. He was the owner of Fullerton Grocery in Corsicana for 46 years. He served as president on the Corbet Oak Valley VFD for a number of years and was currently serving on the board of the Corbet Oak Valley water department.

Over the course of fifty years, Hugh built a herd of red Angus cattle that continues to be in operation today. Its success and longevity are due to his stewardship of the land and his love for raising cattle. He was an advocate and supporter of the Commercial Heifer Division of the Navarro County Youth Expo.

Hugh possessed a kind and compassionate way that made him loved by all. He was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Joann Fullerton and son, Bill Fullerton.

He is survived by his wife of 22 years, Caroline; daughter, Ann Boling; step daughter, Bobbette and husband Elbert Butler of Frost; grandchildren, Will Fullerton and wife Christian of Austin; Clayton Fullerton of Austin; Brett Caroline and husband Randal Schmidt of Ennis; great grandsons, William

Rowell Fullerton and James Schmidt and soon to be great granddaughter, Emilia Schmidt.

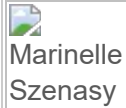

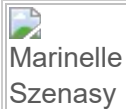

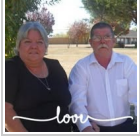
