Jack L. Wigley, beloved husband, father, brother, uncle, and grandfather, died peacefully on July 4, 2013 at home on Richland - Chambers Lake in Streetman. He was born in Paoli, Oklahoma on September 28, 1933, Jack lived most of his life in New Mexico.

Formerly President of Industrial Bus Lines in Carlsbad, Jack was a Navy navigator during the Korean War. He retained friendships and had enjoyed various reunions of Navy veterans. He was a member of the VC-35/VA(AW)-35 and Tailhook Associations. In 2007, Jack was inducted into the Enlisted Combat Aircrew Roll of Honor by the Navy in a ceremony in Mt. Pleasant, SC.
