James W. "Jimmy" Carrigan, 76 of Corsicana passed away suddenly Thursday, April 13, 2017 at "The Family Farm" outside of Conroe, Texas. He was born July 13, 1940 in Athens, Texas to the late Leb "Harry" and Margaret (Wade) Carrigan. He was a Vietnam veteran in the U.S. Army Engineer Division. Among the many medals he received he was extremely proud of his expert marksman award with the M-14.

Jimmy was a member of the Masonic Lodge #174. He attended Rice and Corsicana schools. 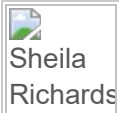

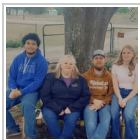
