James Edgar Hodge of Corsicana passed away early Tuesday morning, October 16, 2018 at the age of 89. A celebration of his life will be held 10:00am Friday morning, October 19, 2018 at First Baptist Church in Corsicana with Dr. Danny Reeves officiating. Burial will be at Oakwood Cemetery.

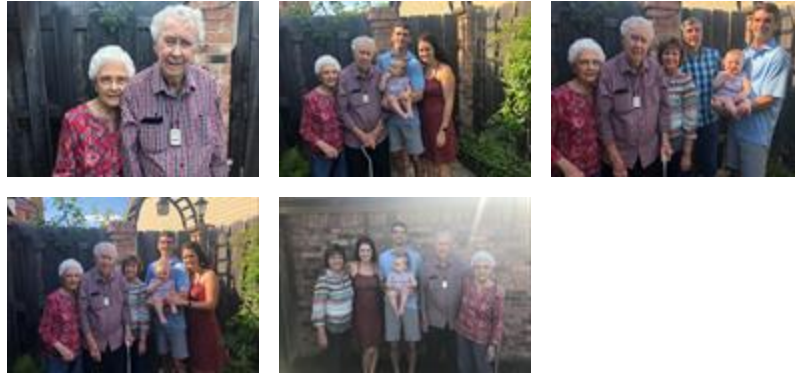

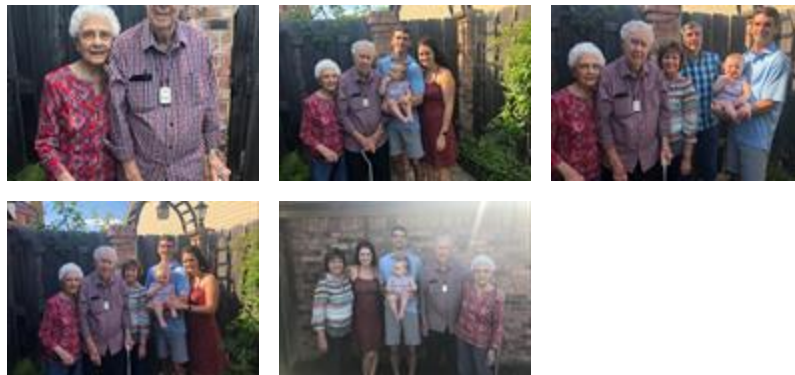
