Janet Ann Jordan, 56, passed away at home Sunday, January 24, 2016 after a short illness. Janet was born on November 9, 1959 in Beatrice, Nebraska to Virgil D. and Saralee E. Cacek. She moved to Maryville, Missouri as a child, and met the love of her life James D. "Doug" Jordan there. They were married in Maryville on September 9, 1978.

Janet dedicated her life to her family foremost, and a long career with Action Pawn of Corsicana where she served as the manager for nearly 30 years. She will be remembered for her selflessness and generosity, her great capacity for love and understanding, and her strength in keeping everyone held together.

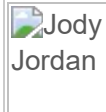
