Jervis R. Manahan, resident of Fairfield, passed away on Monday, November 3, 2008 at his residence at the age of 95. He was born in Fairfield on February 24, 1913 to Jervis Green Manahan and Lottie Childs Manahan. Jervis was born and raised in Fairfield and graduated from Fairfield High School in 1933.
