January 6, 1918 - January 21, 2006

Jimmie I. Horton, 88, of Corsicana passed away Saturday, Jan. 21, 2006 at Navarro Regional Hospital after an extended stay, surrounded by many loving family members. Services will be 4 p.m. today at Wesley United Methodist Church with the Rev. Sandy Sandlin officiating. Interment will follow at the city cemetery in Marlow, Okla. at 1 p.m. Tuesday. She worked at Fort Still, Okla. during World War II. In 1945 she married Howard W. "Shorty" Horton. They lived Marlow, Okla. before transferring with Mobil Pipeline in 1966 to Brazil, Ind. They also lived in Effingham, Ill. before being transferred to Corsicana. Mrs. Horton worked for Charlie and Francis Ellington at Ellington Plumbing until the business closed. She was an active member of the UMW chapter of Wesley United Methodist Church. She also served in numerous positions on various committees and boards at Wesley Methodist. She was preceded in death by her husband Howard on July 28, 1976; brothers Roy Gandy, Elmo Gandy, R.H. "Buddy" Gandy; and sisters Gladys Allen, Leila Martin, OraB Martin and Armelda Simon.
