The four of us drove up into Canada, and then took a single engine sea plane to the fishing lake. It was a bumpy ride, and I got airsick. After that, everything was great. We got up every morning, and went fishing. I felt like we were on the Harold enslie show. We were pulling in 5 or 6 good size fish every day, each of us. One day we went to 'the walleye lake'. It was about a half mile hike to get there. If the walleye was not at least five pounds, we just released it, so it could finish growing up. At that time, before acid rain polluted everything, we just knocked the bugs off of the top of the lake, and drank the water straight from the lake. Dad cooked the walleye, and that was the bestest fish that I have ever eaten. Unfortunately the vacation ended far too soon, but the memories will last a lifetime.
