John Palos Sr. John Palos Sr., age 96, early resident of Corsicana and Navarro County, passed away after a short illness at Navarro Regional Hospital Tuesday morning, Sept. 27, 2005, five days after suffering a stroke at home. John Palos was born Dec. 8, 1908, in Hondo. He retired from the City of Corsicana almost 28 years ago as water and sewer superintendent. He will be remembered as a good, humble and hard-working man who would help anyone at anytime. He endured some difficult times through the wars and the Great Depression, but he provided for his family with a positive “can do” attitude. He was faithful to his wife of 73 years and loved his family, teaching them the virtues of hard work and doing good for others. John had a strong faith in God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son and the Holy Spirit and prayed daily for strength to be a strong and loving father to his children. He is now at peace and enjoys the promises of eternal happiness in heaven. John was preceded in death by his wife, Juanita; parents, grandparents, two sisters and three brothers. He is survived by his daughter, Isabelle Guillen of Temple; and sons, Harry and wife Barbara Palos of Corsicana, Luther and wife Carol Palos of Corsicana, Joe and wife Lorena Palos of Corsicana, John Palos Jr. of Dallas and Lewis Palos of Corsicana.
